Practical Life Homework
Care of Environment: Watering a Plant

Instructions:

1. If you like, put on a smock or apron.
2. Collect a tray you don't mind getting wet and place it on a table.
3. Fill a small pitcher or watering can halfway.
4. Place the watering can by the tray.
5. Collect a sponge or small towel and place it by the tray.
6. Choose a plant that needs water and place it on the tray.
7. Hold the handle of the watering can with your dominant hand and place your subdominant hand under the spout to steady the can.
8. Water the plant, moving the spout around the plant to make sure you cover all of the soil with water.
9. Use your sponge to clean up any spills.
10. Return the plant to its original location.
11. Return the sponge and tray to their original locations.
12. Wash your hands if necessary.
