Earth Day Collage

Materials:

- Paper plate
- Blue and green tissue paper or construction paper
- Old magazines, newspapers, scrap paper, or any other safe, similar materials
- Glue
- Picture of Earth

Instructions:

1. **Look** at your picture of Earth. **Point** to the green areas and **say** land. **Point** to the blue areas and **say** water.
2. **Tear** blue and green pieces of tissue or construction paper.
3. **Glue** the tissue paper onto the paper plate.
4. Using an old magazine or newspaper, **cut out** pictures of animals or objects in nature, e.g., mountains, flowers, birds, insects, fish, seashells.
5. **Glue** your chosen pictures onto the plate.
6. Optional: **Add** a small label that says, "Happy Earth Day."
7. Post your artwork in honor of Earth Day:)
