**Practical Life Homework**  
Care of Environment: Sweeping

**Instructions:**

1. Bring a child-friendly broom and dustpan to an area that needs sweeping.
2. Hold the broom with your dominant hand near the middle of the broomstick and your subdominant hand towards the top of the broomstick.
3. Using short gentle strokes, move the broom across the floor to sweep the debris into one area of the room.
4. Once all the debris is in one pile on the floor, put the broom aside and collect the dustpan.
5. Place the dustpan next to the pile and pick up the broom.
6. Crouching down, hold the dustpan with your subdominant hand and use your dominant hand to slowly sweep the debris into the dustpan.
7. Carefully lift the dustpan to check if any debris landed underneath the dustpan.
8. Carefully empty the contents of the dustpan into a garbage bin.
9. Return the broom and dustbin to their proper location.
10. Wash your hands thoroughly.
